

Spelling Tic-Tac-Toe Project Guide

Each student is responsible for completing three activities from the following choices. Your three activities must follow the rules of tic-tac-toe (i.e., three in a row). All activities are due Thursday at the start of school. Please staple all three activities to this sheet.

<p>First write your words the way you usually do it. Then, try writing the list with your other hand.</p>	<p>Fold a piece of paper into thirds. Write your words in column one, copy them in column two, fold and write your words from memory in column three. Unfold to check your work.</p>	<p>Number the alphabet from 1-26. Write your spelling words, then change them to the alphabet code.</p>
<p>Write your words in a pyramid formation.</p> <p>Ex. boat b bo boa boat</p>	<p>Type your word list on the computer using an interesting font.</p>	<p>Make pairs of cards for each of your words. Play a game of concentration.</p>
<p>Write sentences using your spelling words.</p>	<p>Write your entire list end-to-end as one long word (like a train). Use a different colored crayon for each word.</p>	<p>Draw and color a picture. Hide your spelling words inside your picture.</p>

Circle all of the spelling words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Delicious Words</p> <p>Write your words in whipped cream, peanut butter, pudding, or anything you can eat! Have a parent sign below confirming that you completed this activity.</p> <hr/>
<p style="text-align: center;">Words-in-Words</p> <p>Write your words and then write at least 2 words made from each.</p> <p>Example: friend dine end die rid</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Criss- Cross Words</p> <p>Write two of your spelling words that have a common letter so that they criss-cross. Be sure to use all of your words.</p> <p>Example: p words o u d</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Surround Words</p> <p>Write your words on graph paper and outline in colors.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Perimeter</p> <p>Write your words on graph paper and then find the perimeter of each word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">3D Words</p> <p>Use modeling clay or any other dough to make your words. Have a parent sign below confirming that you completed this activity.</p> <hr/>	<p style="text-align: center;">Ransom Words</p> <p>Write your words by cutting out letters in a newspaper or magazine and glue them on paper.</p>

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<p style="text-align: center;">Silly Sentences</p> <p>Make silly sentences using all of your words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Words in Cursive</p> <p>Write all of your spelling words in cursive.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Telephone Words</p> <p>Translate your words into numbers using the telephone keypad.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Acrostic Poem</p> <p>Make an acrostic poem with each spelling word.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Read Red Elephant Ant Dog</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Word Shapes</p> <p>Write your spelling words in the form of shapes. You can use more than one word to make a shape.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Painted Words</p> <p>Paint all of your spelling words on a piece of paper.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Fraction Spelling</p> <p>Create fractions to represent the number of vowels and consonants in each word.</p> <p>Ex: Friend</p> <p>Vowels = 2/6 Consonants = 4/6</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Classify Words</p> <p>Make a table sorting each spelling word according to parts of speech.</p> <p>Ex. Dog = Noun Run = Verb</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Word Definitions</p> <p>Look up each spelling word in the dictionary and write down one definition for each word.</p>

Write your spelling words and add how much they are worth. Consonants are worth 5 points and vowels are worth 7. Told $5+7+5+5=22$	Write your spelling words with dots in pencil. Then use marker or crayon to connect the dots.	Write your words. Circle the vowels in each word.
